



Steps in boundary determination • Allocation of territory – the parties agree on a broad division of territory, thus establishing 'spheres of influence'. Political decisions taken. • Delimitation/Delineation of a line – political, legal and technical experts decide on a precise alignment of the boundary, illustrated on maps. Treaty drawn up. • Demarcation on the ground – the agreed line is transferred from the map to the ground where it is physically marked with pillars, posts, fences, etc. • Administration and Management – the demarcated line is maintained and routinely managed by the neighbouring states.
